Streptococcus pneumoniae (S. pneumoniae), strain 1175579 was isolated in 2014 from a sputum sample of a 49-yearold female in the United States. It was deposited as resistant to ampicillin, ceftriaxone, erythromycin, penicillin, tetracycline and trimethoprim/sulfamethoxazole. NR-56692 was produced by inoculation of the deposited material into Brain Heart Infusion broth and grown for 1 day at 37° C in an aerobic atmosphere with 5% CO₂. Broth inoculum was added to Tryptic Soy with 5% defibrinated sheep blood agar kolles, which were grown for 1 day at 37° C in an aerobic atmosphere with 5% CO₂ to produce this lot. Quality control testing was completed under propagation conditions unless otherwise noted.
